

The GNC at Coquina Elementary has over 35 registered. From October – December of 2014 fourteen (14) children prayed and asked Jesus to come into their lives.

The GNC at Mims Elementary has over 30 registered. From October – December of 2014 nine (9) children prayed and asked Jesus to come into their lives.

The GNC at Oak Park Elementary has over 30 registered. From October – November of 2014 five (5) children prayed and asked Jesus to come into their lives.

Imperial Estates Elementary has agreed to have a club start in Oct. 2015 **IF** volunteers are found to staff this Club by then. Currently we have 1 volunteer. Your prayers would be appreciated, that the Lord would raise up these volunteers.

We also ask for your prayers for an “open door” at Apollo Elementary in Titusville. Once this door is “opened” we will have a GNC in every elementary school in Titusville and Mims.

The children of America need the Lord in their lives and I am so thankful that we have a ministry to them in our schools.
