

## Reflections from Pastor David . . . . .

Just outside my office door is a small box sign. It was given to me a couple of years ago by one of the ladies in our church. It has a very simple, four-word message:

*“Simplify Christmas, Celebrate Christ”*

When Lorrie gave it to me, her timing was perfect. I was in the middle of my annual sermon preparations for Christmas. My schedule was quickly filling up with church events, Christmas dinners, ministerial gatherings and much more.

That year, I took that little box sign and hung it by my office desk. Throughout the season, each time I glanced at it I was reminded to slow down and remember Christmas is exactly what the sign says, a celebration of Christ.

When Jesus came into this world, the words of the ancient psalmist burst into reality:

*“... When God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, ‘Let all God’s angels worship him’.”*

On that starry night in Bethlehem, the angels celebrated Christ. The shepherds followed suit and worshipped the baby in the manger. A couple of years later, when the Magi arrived and found Jesus, they worshipped him, too.

This year, in the midst of all of the travelling, events, gift-giving, parties, and the rest, I invite you practice the words on the box sign outside my office door:

*“Simplify Christmas, Celebrate Christ”*


## MISSIONARY PRAYER REQUESTS - DECEMBER 2018

Eagle College started in 2007 with 55 students from preschool through 6th grade. The college was born out of the prayers of two local pastors from Ciudad Miguel Aleman and a group of individuals from West Michigan, both whom had a heart for Christian education. The local Templo Belen Church helped get the school off the ground, as they met in their modest facility. However, the walls could not hold them and they soon were turning children away and found themselves in need of a school facility to call their own. Thanks to endless donations, volunteers, and prayers, construction, which began in 2010, is nearing completion.

Eagle College is a private school located on the border town of Ciudad Miguel Aleman, Tamaulipas Mexico, across the border from Roma, Texas. The school is in its 6th year now and is highly acclaimed as one of the top schools in the state. Along with the required curriculum, the students receive knowledge of the English language and an education based on Biblical truths. Many needs still remain to be met. English speaking teachers are needed because of the large influx of students. There will be needs for school supplies and technology to enhance learning. Also, there are numerous projects to still be completed on the new campus. During 2018 we budgeted \$1,200 for the year = \$100 each month.

As the words of the song state:

**God put millions of doors in the world for His love to walk through. One of these doors is you.**

Thank you so much for allowing the love of God to go through these doors to a school, to a child in Mexico.




