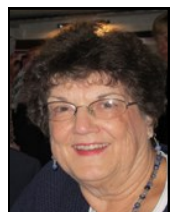


Lee Miller—Vice President

Some of you know me as the driver of the golf cart shuttle between the parking lots and church, some as the chairman of the Men's Breakfast Group, some as the summer sound board operator at Sunday services, others as one of the greeters and ushers for the Sunday night concerts. For over 23 years, living here part time in Florida I have helped the church whenever there was a need that I could fulfill. Now that I am retired and living here full time I am ready to serve full time on the Board.

I was born and raised in a small town in southwest Michigan by God loving parents who took me to church every time the doors were open beginning at two weeks old. With this great beginning it still took me until I was 22 to understand that I needed Jesus as my Savior.

When I look back, it is amazing to see the path the Lord used to get me where He wanted me. At the age of 15 I knew the Lord wanted me to serve Him helping families at the most difficult time of their lives, at the death of a loved one. On Sept. 1, 1962 I married my school sweetheart, Ruth. After we were married we worked together so that I could complete 3 years at Western Michigan University and 1 year at Wayne State University's school of Mortuary Science preparing me to earn my Michigan Mortuary Science license in 1966. In 1973 we purchased our first funeral home which was in our home town of Bloomingdale, MI. God blessed us with two wonderful sons. Brian and his wife, Angie now live in South Carolina. Our youngest son, Scott, was diagnosed with acute duchenne muscular dystrophy when he was 8 and died in our arms when he was 17. By retirement in 2010 we were operating three funeral homes in small rural communities in Michigan. During our years I served the Michigan Funeral Directors Assn. as a member of their Board of Directors for 12 years and served as President in 1995. I also served on several committees of the National Funeral Directors Assn.



Judy Evans—Finance

Judy and her husband, Bob, began wintering at TGO in 2005 and joined Great Outdoors Church in 2006. Judy sings in the choir and has served on the Outreach Committee (previously Evangelism Committee) for 9 years. She served on the GOCC Board in 2013 and 2014. Responsibilities included leadership of monthly meetings, oversight of visitations within the community, new member preparation, follow-through with new members, etc.

Judy set up and maintained several data bases for GOCC, including the attendees at the dedication of the new building and the Service/Time and Talent volunteer information. She has developed a master file of all members. She is active in choir, WIC, a WIC bible study group and a small group bible study. At her home church in Iowa, Judy has served as an active member and chair of the Finance Committee (\$500,000 operating budget), Stewardship (600 pledging units), Nominations and Staff/Parish committees and she sings in the choir.

Judy's 35 year career was in health care, first as a medical technologist and lab director. After obtaining her master's degree, Judy served in two vice president positions at a 350 bed hospital. The last few years of Judy's employment were spent leading process improvement and measurement of patient satisfaction. The gifts Judy would bring to the board are strong organizational skills, oversight and management of financial operations, budget management, and a watchful eye for how processes might be improved.



Mike Zeigler—Facilities

I am the second generation of what is now a three generation family business. The business was started in 1947 by my parents, and has been in the same location since 1952. The physical building has been enlarged four times. The first addition was the neighboring house in 1958. The second addition was a new two story structure of approximately 5000' in 1960. The third addition came in 1971 after my tour in the Air Force. At this point in time almost all of the work done in the physical plant had been done by my father, uncle and myself. The last addition was a 6000' new building in 1978 bringing the total size to approximately 15,000 sq. ft.. The age spread of the various buildings is 100 years. It has presented a few challenges over the years.

In 2000, my son and I turned the upstairs of two of the houses into a 3000 sq ft apartment for him to live in when he got out of the Navy and joined the family business. I am sure this position for the church will also present challenges and I am looking forward to meeting them.

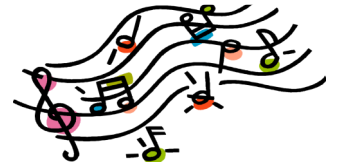
GRIEF SHARE

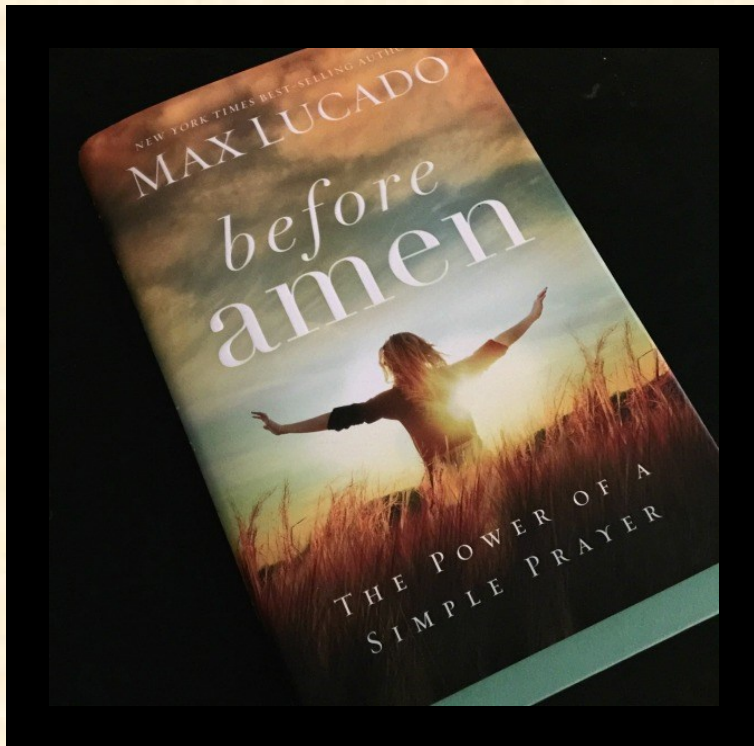
