Activity Kits for children or grandchildren who attend church while visiting are available in the Narthex and include crayons, coloring books and reading material in helping to keep the young ones busy during the church service.

Care Notes are displayed in the Narthex at the entry/exit doors. These are free booklets that give easy-to-read guidance covering grief and loss, spiritual care, family care, mental wellness and more. We invite you to look through the Care Notes for assistance in coping with the many challenges and stress that often occur in life.

Food Pantry and More is able to provide the much needed food, clothing and funds in assisting many organizations that in turn help many people who have numerous needs: physically, emotionally, spiritually and more. And this is made possible through the kindness and donations of The Great Outdoors community. Tubs are located outside the church office and can be dropped off at the home of Bill and Lynda Shaw at 147 Dragonfly.





We will leave the Church parking lot at 11:00 am.



Congratulations to WIC and all the hard-working volunteers and participants.







He named the place Bethel. (Gen. 28:10-22)


Here the Lord changed his name to Israel.
