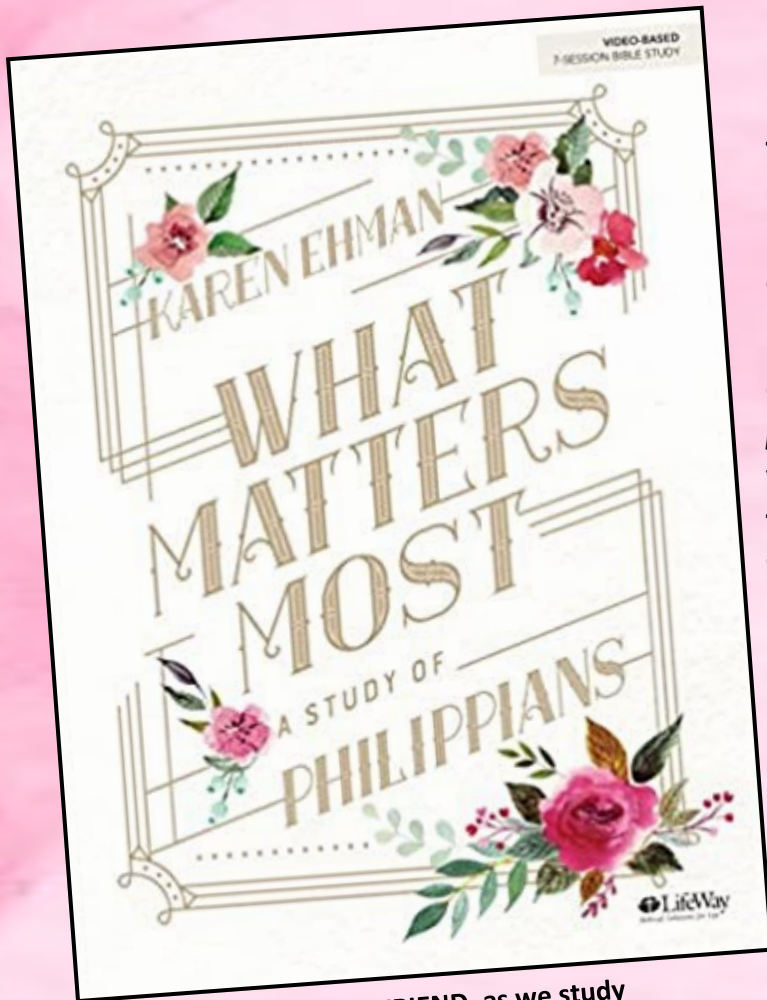

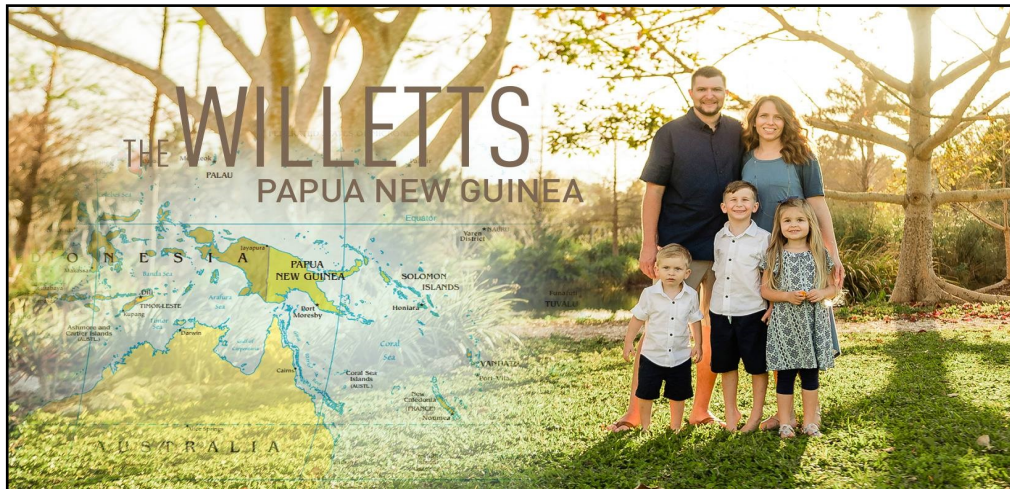

WILLETT FAMILY RAYJESSICA AND THREE CHILDREN



The Willett family visited our Missions Committee on Thursday, January 18th. Ray presented a slide show of their work in PNG (Papua New Guinea).

They have finished their first term in the field in PNG and are in the area for a few months before they return to the field in August. He explained many of the stages they go through. One item is Culture Language Acquisition. There are over 850 people groups in PNG many with their own dialect. There is an international language they have learned, but as they move into a new village, they have to learn that particular language also. They have done Bush Orientation by actually going to the Bush and getting acclimated to what living in the jungle would be like. They have been through some scary moments (like Ray getting hijacked) but found that even in the scary moments they were able to give testimony to God's care.

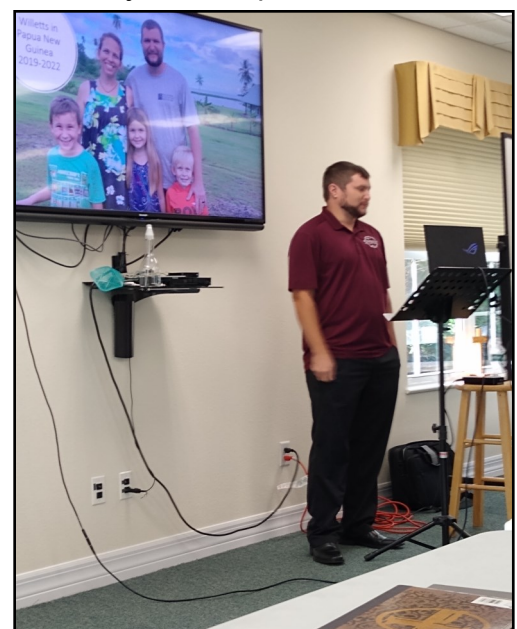
Their goal is to plant a church with two or three co-worker couples. Their plan is to teach the Bible Chronologically and develop leaders from inside the church to build the church and develop elders to take over. They have been in search of a team. He said they have had to recalculate their finding a team - - actually twice now. Ray is managing the base in Madang. Jessica is mom to three, homeschooling, doing chores around the house and leading a ladies Bible Study. She sees to getting filtered water early in the morning and home schooling before something arises. They say that PNG is the land of the unexpected - like pigs or crocodiles! The weather is like Florida but the heat is hotter and the humidity is higher. They know of John and Bonnie Nystrom (other missionaries we support in PNG under Wycliffe Translators). They have not met them but use often the Wycliffe's airplanes.

The long term ministry plan is to build up a church. Not a physical (brick and mortar type) but home churches or under the trees. They currently are planning to minister to the Vitu people. They are 6-10,000 unreached people on three islands. Unreached are people who have never heard of Jesus.

The Vitu Islands are a volcanic group with an area of 37 sq mi located in the Bismarck Sea off New Britain, in the southwestern Pacific Ocean. They are not technically part of the Bismarck Archipelago. Administratively they are part of Papua New Guinea.

Prayers for the family:

- Learning the heart language they need;
- A team or teams;
- Courage;
- Good health;
- Boldness in preaching the word;
- Ability to handle separation from family at a far distance and
- Constant dependence on the Holy Spirit

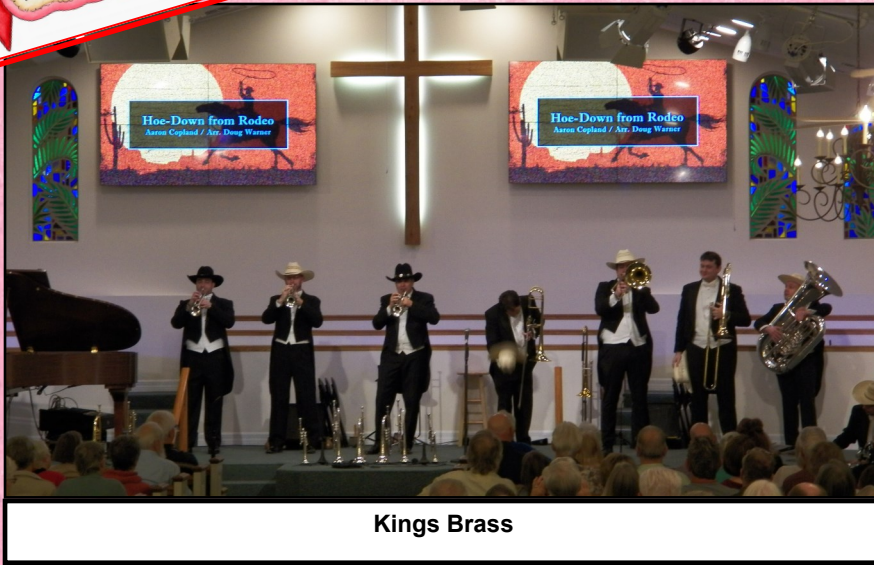

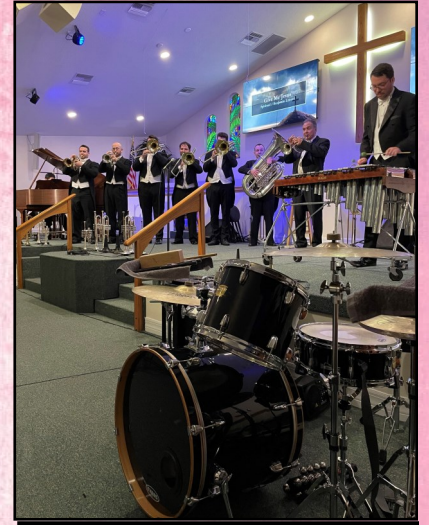

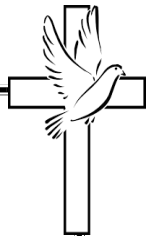
