MADERNA VACCINE SHOTS :

Forms are required for getting on the list to receive the Covid-19 vaccine from The Fl Dept. of Health, Brevard. You must be 60 or older and a resident of Florida (drivers license or utility bill required for proof). Forms are available in the Narthex during Sat. and Sun. service hours or you may come to narthex and fill one out between the hours of 10:00 am and 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. Only four people are allowed in at a time. You can also download the form online at Brevard's Health Department website. The form must be turned into the church office and your name will be entered on a first -come-first-serve list. This is a short-notice schedule so we will contact you by email or phone. **IMPORTANT-**if you get the shot from another source, please let us know so we can fill your spot. You may pick a form up on the way out after service and drop in the box outside of office.
