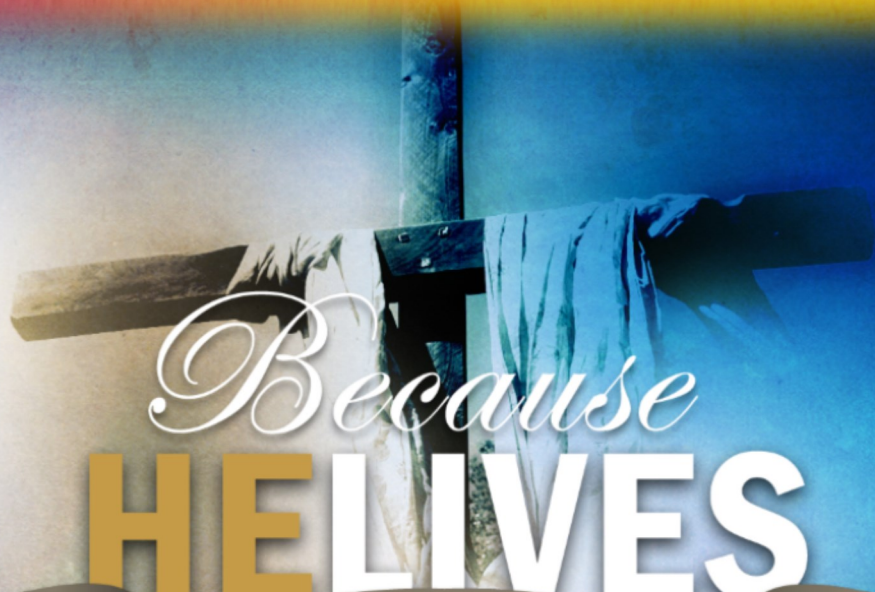

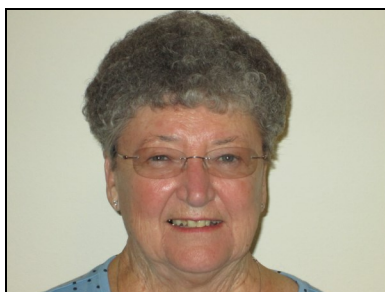

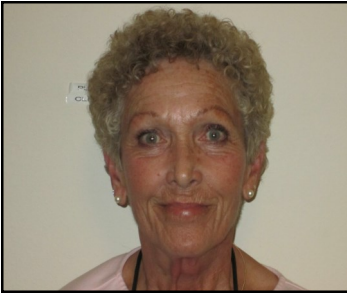
Meals are prepared on the volunteer premise, purchase at a local deli, store, fast food, or even pizza delivery.

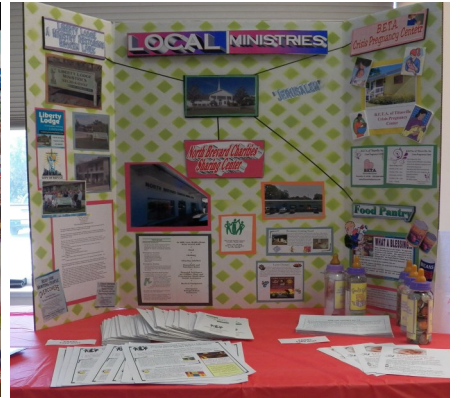
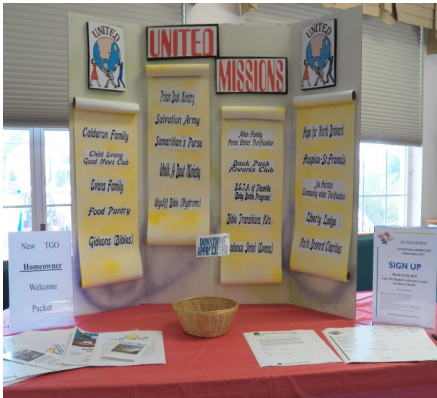

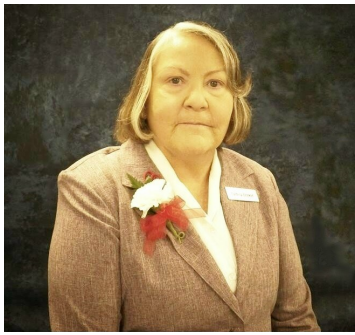
