With that one statement, the Christmas child, now a fully-grown man, answered the most important question about Christmas - "Why did God send Jesus?"

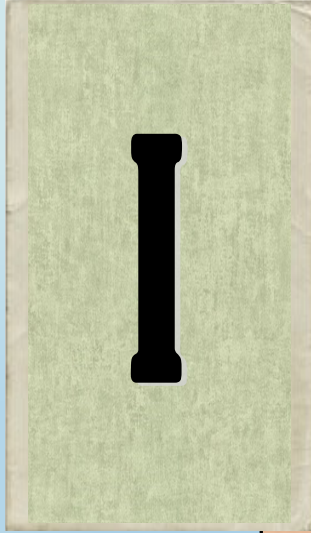
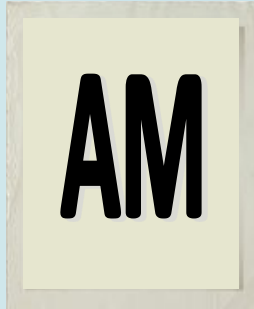
Some people believe God sent His Son to give us a new moral code, to emulate a new model of life, or present us a new philosophical outlook.

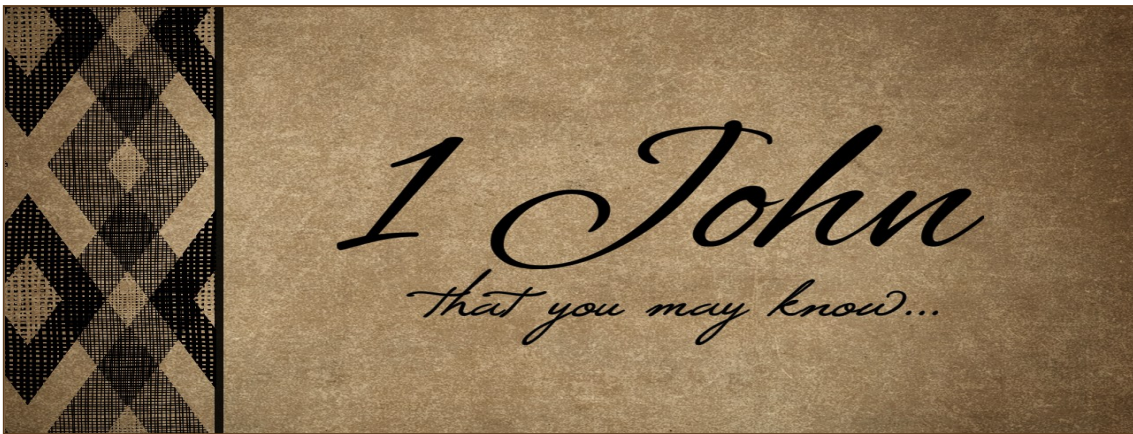

As director of the Yanomamö school, Keila focuses much time and energy on training the Yanomamö teachers, creating materials for the school, and teaching the children in both Yanomamö and Spanish.

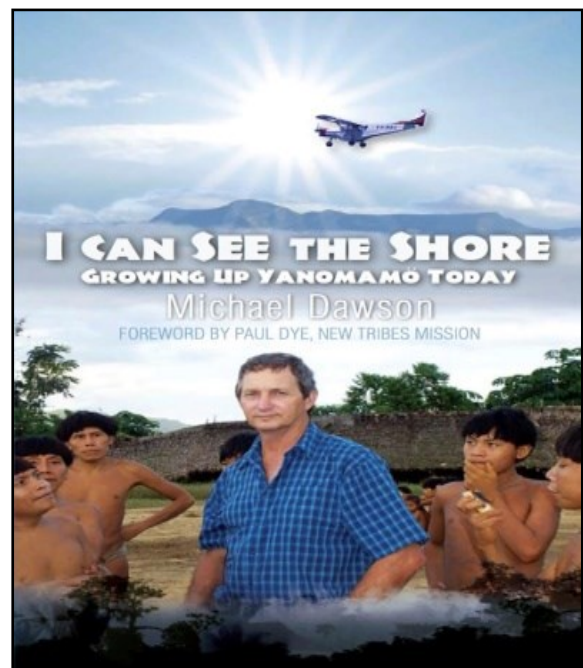

NATIONAL SPACE CLUB SPACE WORKERS HALL OF FAME 2020 HALL OF FAME AWARD: J.B. KUMP

Kump is a former member of the military and corporate Space programs as a communications professional.

As an Air Force Public Affairs officer in 1974, then Captain Kump began his long, professional affiliation with America's Space Program when he was assigned to the Space & Missile Systems Organization (SAMSO) at Los Angeles Air Station in California. During that assignment, Kump created communications to inform the American public on such new space utilization programs as the GPS system, meteorological satellite technology, the use of space for communications and the development of many new land-based technologies discovered as a result of the military Space program. While at SAMSO, Kump was asked to serve as narrator for a series of interviews with such military Space pioneers as General Sam Phillips for USC's oral history collection. Later, as a Lieutenant Colonel, Kump returned to that same organization in Los Angeles as the Director of the Office of Communications. Kump was there as the command's lead communicator in the post-Challenger rebirth of the military's heavy launch capacity. He was also involved in the Air Force's participation in the formation of Florida's Spaceport organization and the beginnings of the commercial space industry. After Kump retired from the Air Force in 1989, he moved to Florida where he served as Media Relations Director for the Lockheed Space Operations Company. In that capacity he represented the Shuttle Processing Company at a number of Shuttle launch and related events. Later, as District Director for Congressman Dave Weldon, he assisted the Representative in advocating for Space in a number of ways. Finally, Kump returned to Kennedy Space Center as Director of Communications and External relations for the Boeing Corporation.

Kump's past recognitions/awards:

- Recipient of the Defense Meritorious Service Medal and others for his work as an advocate for the U.S. military Space programs.
- Chairman of the Joint Industry Press Center (JIPC) during the Space Shuttle Program.
- Recipient of the 2000 Public Affairs Professional of the Year award from the Space Coast Chapter, FPRA (Florida Public Relations Association).
- Long time member and former program chairman for the National Space Club, Florida Committee.
- Public Speaker on Space related topics at numerous organizational events in Florida, California, Washington, Washington, D.C. and international locations.
- As Chairman of the Titusville Area Chamber of Commerce, Kump ensured Space Advocacy was a major plank in the Chamber's platform, mission and vision.
- Served as a citizen organizer and participant in several annual trips to Washington, D.C. to advocate to Congress and the Administration for funding of Space.
- Travelled with such important economic development missions as a Florida delegation to Brazil seeking joint business opportunities and a visit with Elon Musk in his early, El Segundo Space-X manufacturing facility - all to advocate for Space and to develop Florida's Space industry.
