It is hard to imagine what the season would be like without Christmas carols, cantatas, or even Bing Crosby singing "White Christmas".

Music has been a big part of the Christmas season for centuries, but they didn't originate in Medieval



Europe or colonial America. The very first Christmas carols go back much farther than that. They began as spontaneous outbursts of praise from people who had remarkable experiences connected with Christ's birth.

Luke the physician was the first to record the original four Christmas carols – in the first two chapters of his gospel. All four songs were part of the narrative of Jesus' Incarnation.

The Early Church knew these original Christmas Carols by heart. When the Scriptures were translated into Latin, the four songs recorded by Luke were given Latin titles:

Mary's Song, found in Luke 1:48-55 is called "The Magnificat". Zechariah's Song, from Luke 1:67-80 is called "The Benedictus". The song the angels sang in Luke 2:14 is called, "Gloria in Excelsis, while Simeon's Song, found in Luke 2:29-32 is called "The Nunc Dimittis"

This Christmas season, starting on November 29th, I am going to share a sermon series based on these passages. I think you are going to find a wonderful and new connection between the four original Christmas carols and faith in God.
