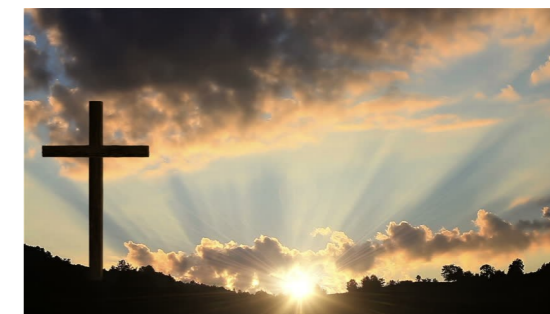
HELPING HANDS needs volunteers to assist group leaders. Sign up sheets will be in the Fellowship Hall today after the church service.
