



Missions...

2023 Recap:



In 2023, the missions committee distributed \$105,000 to 22 different ministries and missionaries. \$76,000 of this was from the church budget (15% of the total church budget) and the rest was from special offerings and designated gifts.

Below is a summary of where these funds went:

- \$22,135 to 6 local ministries: North Brevard Charities, Good News Prison/Jail Ministry, Life Recaptured, Children's Hunger Project, Christian Ministry Concepts and Nana's House.
- \$34,750 to 6 ministries based in the United States and Mexico: Air Mobile Ministries, Samaritan's Purse, Prison Book Project, Eagle College (Mexico), Stride Ministries (Utah) and the Gideons.
- \$48,837 to 10 international missionaries/missionary families: the Willetts (Papua New Guinea), the Shropshires (Senegal, West Africa), the Klebs (Southeast Asia), the Dawsons (Venezuela), the Nystroms (Papua New Guinea), the Devkotas (Nepal), Maggie V. (Far East), Rafique (Pakistan), Masih (Pakistan) and Tass Saada (Israel/Gaza).

In addition, the missions committee...

- Hosted visits by four missionary families: the Willetts, the Dawsons, the Shropshires and the Klebs.
- Facilitated the collection of more than 200 shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child, 92 Christmas gifts for North Brevard Charities' Christmas Angel Program, and over 100 lbs. of socks and underwear for local homeless shelters.
- Volunteered with Samaritans Purse, Prison Book Project, Good News Prison and Jail Ministry, North Brevard Charities and Nana's House.
