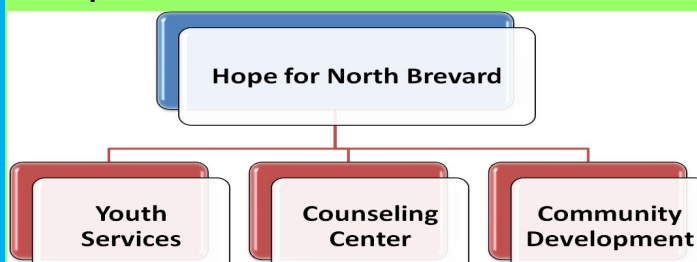

As of the end of May, there have been 244 pavers and 76 niches purchased. The committee is now working on a plan to purchase another columbarium for delivery in the fourth quarter of 2014. The new unit would be the same in appearance as the first unit. The cost is now being negotiated and it is anticipated that there will be an increase in the base price of the columbarium.

There is a short term issue regarding closing the garden gate in the evening hours. Please know that the garden is always open from dawn to dusk and if the gate is closed during that time, just come right in and do not worry that the gate was closed.
