From January through Easter the church celebrates two worship services to accommodate all of our worshippers.

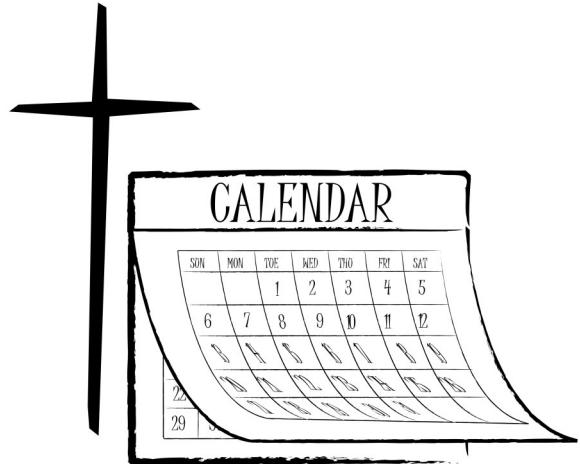
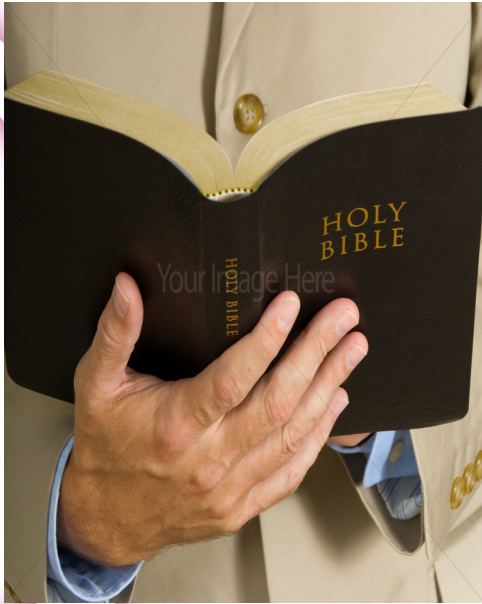

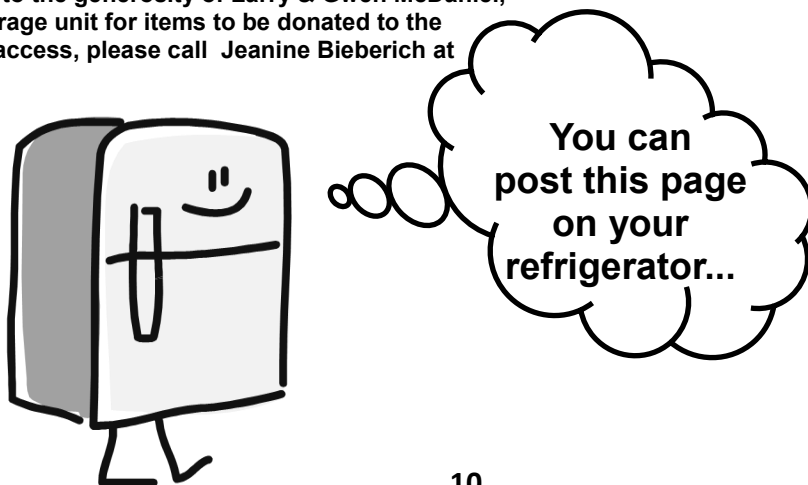
