Have you been wondering how you can include the Great Outdoors Community Church in your estate planning, and thereby becoming a member of the Legacy Fund? Over the next few months we'll be giving examples of the various ways you can include the GOCC in your estate planning.

### A Charitable Gift Annuity

One creative way to include the GOCC in your estate plans is the Charitable Gift Annuity. Here's how it works:

Mary is 66 and her husband, Mike is 65. They would like to include the GOCC in their estate plans, but due to uncertain economic times, they need income now. To meet both needs, Mary and Mike choose the Charitable Gift Annuity.

Example:

- ◆ If they invest \$20,000 in a Charitable Gift Annuity, they will receive an immediate \$5,544 Federal Tax deduction.
- ◆ They will also receive \$860 a year, or 4.3% of their investment, for the remainder of their lives.
- ◆ Upon the death of the surviving spouse, the remainder of the Charitable Gift Annuity will be received by the GOCC.
- ◆ The older the couple is at the time of the Annuity, the higher the annual income and larger the Federal Tax deduction.
- ◆ Talk with your Financial Advisor to determine if this is a viable alternative for you and your family.

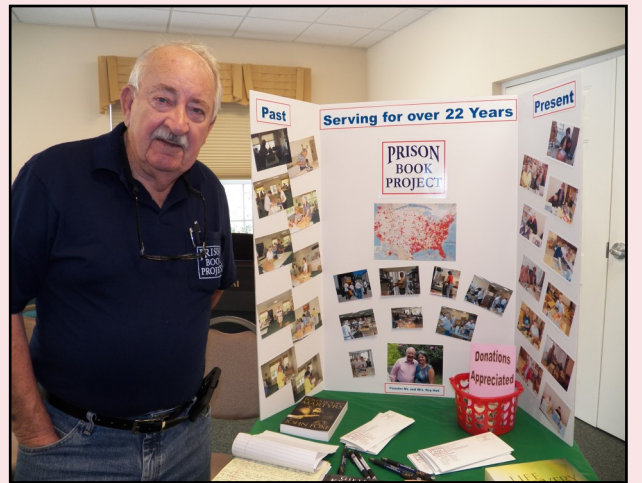
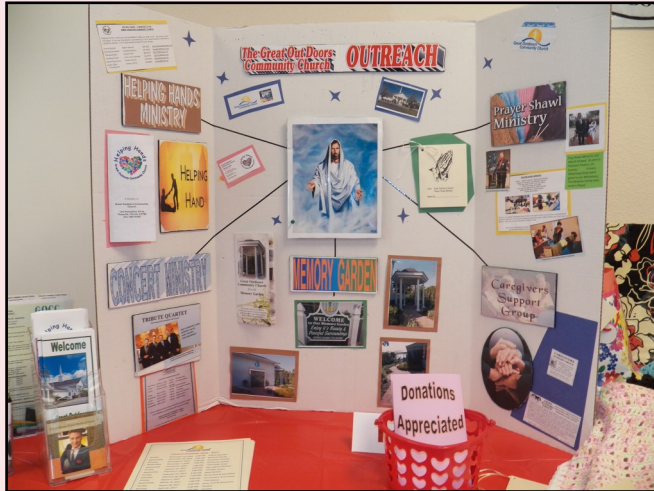

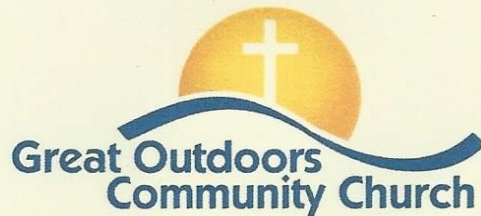
