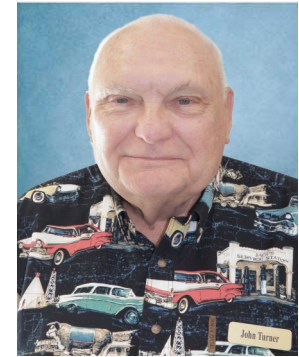
This service provides primary care givers a temporary relief away from home while the volunteer sits with the homebound individual for no more than four hours at a time. Volunteers are not expected to do any nursing procedures, housework, laundry, cooking or assist the client with anything physical. Activities between the client and volunteer may include watching tv, playing games, etc. Emergency contact numbers must be provided by the caregiver to the volunteer.



TEMPORARY MEALS

We provide meals for individuals in TGO who have an injury, illness or are recovering from surgery and cannot prepare or obtain meals. This assistance can range from a few days to no longer than two weeks. Meals are provided by volunteers at their own expense and may include home cooked meals, take out or commercially prepared meals.
