The God Who Breaks Through

It's an interesting story, with an interesting ending.

In Second Samuel, David is crowned king over all of Israel's tribes. The Philistines, Israel's enemies, are concerned about "David the Giant-Killer" consolidating such power, so they assembled their warriors in a valley outside of Jerusalem.

David's army was greatly outnumbered by the Philistine forces, but God promised him victory. David boldly attacked the larger forces and scored an overwhelming victory. In the aftermath, he praises God and calls Him "Baal Perazim" - "The God Who Breaks Through".

As I said, it's an unusual story with an unusual ending. But notice this, "breaking through" is one of God's specialties. At Christ's Incarnation, The Word took on human flesh and broke into history. For some thirty-three years God broke through the impossible circumstances of humans through His Son's miraculous ministry.

And then, when Jesus' death on the Cross appeared to end the entire campaign against Sin, Satan, and Death - God broke through once again. On the Day of Pentecost, Peter proclaimed, "But God raised Him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on Him." (Acts 2:42)

At the Resurrection, "The God Who Breaks Through - had done it once again. He broke into history and filled the world with His irresistible power. He demonstrated that He is still in the miracle-working business.

Happy Resurrection! He Is Risen!

On March 8, 2026, Grace Dillon spoke to the congregation about YWAM (Youth With A Mission). YWAM works with young adults for 6 months in a discipleship training school. Grace explained the first 3 months is the lecture phase where training is done on hearing God's voice, doing evangelism and world missions.

The second phase is the outreach portion, normally overseas to another country.

Grace told the congregation she received a calling when she was 8 years old, and that God called her to Kenya to work with orphans. As Grace got older, she knew God was calling her to the Missions field long term. When she graduated high school, Grace decided to pursue a Missionary Training School, and she found one in Washington, D.C.—YWAM. Amazingly, YWAM in Washington D.C. has a 24/7 worship and prayer tent on the National Mall.

Grace stated, "It's amazing because God honors big prayers, and big prayers honor Him. So in our nation's capital, we are praying for our nation. It is amazing lifting Jesus up in our nation's capital."

Between October and December of 2025, Grace helped lead a team on a YWAM outreach to Israel. They spent 40 days ministering to Muslims and Jews. Grace said she is really excited for what God has in store for her.

Grace asked the congregation to please pray for her, support and encourage her.

Women in the Church ("WIC") presented Grace with a monetary donation and have voted to support her through 2026-2027.





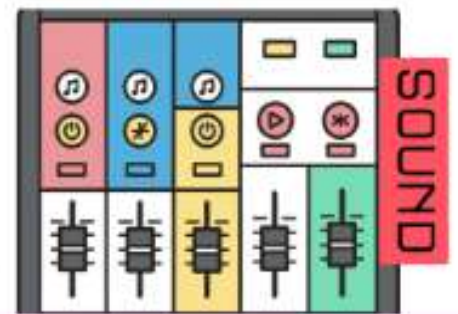

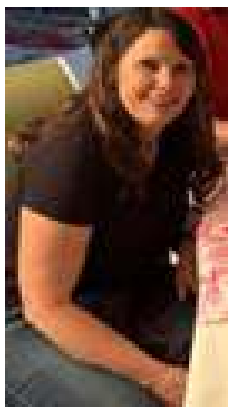

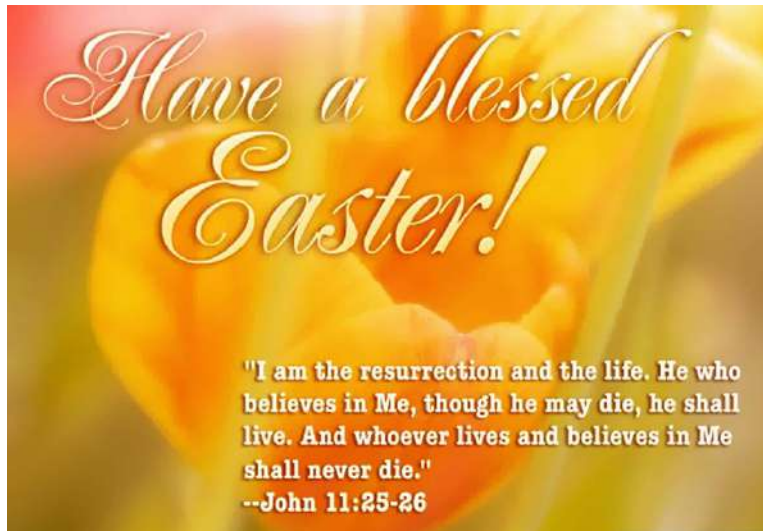
