HISTORY

The church had its beginning in 1990, when a small group met for Bible Study. In 1993, the group began regular Sunday worship services at the Plantation Manor. At that time, Rev. Ken Vander Broek became the lead pastor. In April of 1994, plans for a church building were drawn up for construction on land donated by Jack Eckerd. The church held its first service in the new building on Palm Sunday, April 5, 1998.

Pastor Jeff Moody became the lead pastor in 2000. As the congregation grew, more room for ministry became necessary. Planning began in 2005 and the congregation moved into its newly expanded campus in 2009. Due to God's grace and a generous congregation, the 1.3-million-dollar expansion was paid off in two years

Upon Pastor Moody's retirement, Dr. David W. Price became lead pastor on January 1, 2012. Thereafter, Pastors J.B. Kump and Dan Zahn joined the staff as associate pastors.

GOVERNANCE

Our church Board includes men and women who are elected by the congregation at its annual business meeting. This includes a president, vice-president, treasurer, secretary, and various ministry team leaders, who serve three-year terms. The leadership team meets each month during the primary season. Zoom or phone meetings are used during the summer months. Church business is conducted as specified by our Constitution and By-Laws.

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

Our church offers full memberships for those who have GOCC as their primary church, and associate memberships for those who wish to also retain membership in a secondary church. Full and associate members are eligible to serve on the main leadership team and are voting members.
